Dear Prayer Partners,

At the time I thought it would be a great way to minister to these residents if the SHARinG Org could build ramps on these buildings for them. After I met with the management of the apartment buildings they decided to scrap my original plan of wood-structured ramps and construct a cement structure instead! I am excited because I had my doubts about whether we could actually get the ramps in place, since our funding for this project was limited and I was not sure if we would see the cooperation necessary to do this project. However, as Mother Teresa so often commented, "If God wants it done, it will be." Ground has already been broken, and we hope to see the ramps completed this summer.
