Our efforts have been such a joy and this ministry a pleasure. We are prayerfully anticipating many more years of serving those who are not able to attend a church on Sunday mornings and we hope that you are too.

This past month we have responded financially to Samaritan's Purse as they desire to rebuild the Christian church in Sudan. The church was destroyed by Islamic forces during decades of war. During this time, many of the Christians were executed and many fled for their lives. The Christians that fled during that time are beginning to return to their homes, and Samaritan's Purse wants to help them rebuild. This past month I learned of the physical needs of a couple of our prayer partners. One prayer partner is undergoing physical therapy to fight the effects of paralysis, and the other is undergoing surgery to have a mass removed. As I thought about the many amazing things that God has filled our world with, I was impressed that Jesus is amazed at none of it. The child that is born and the sun that rises are both doing exactly what He created them to do. However, what does amaze Him is when you and I lack faith... I found this message to be exactly what I needed at that moment, and I am happy to share it with you if you may have need of it too.
