Please pray that we will be able to meet these requests in the not too distant future.

Thanks to all of you for your contributions to our ministry. We now have monthly contributions that cover about 25% of our total budget and we are only \$200 in monthly contributions away from being able to meet the requests of the care facilities on the waiting list. It is exciting to watch as God provides for our work. This ministry provides so many people with the love and Gospel of Jesus Christ, we are confident that He will provide what we need to move forward. We have sent the paperwork to Lansing to incorporate as our own ministry! I've been working to put together the executive board, and if everything goes as planned then we will have a leadership board that will help us to realize our Mission and Vision!

This month we will be working in conjunction with the WWTS ladies group from the Community Baptist Church of Richmond in a joint fund raising event. The event is called "RISK<sup>®</sup> Night" and we will have 36 men playing on six game boards, attempting to dominate their respective worlds! I've held these RISK<sup>®</sup> Nights before, and they are always a great success with the guys. We are looking forward to a fun night of world conquest all around. I've included a flyer, and I hope that those of you who live in the area would come out to conquer the world with us! (Please pre-register if you plan to attend because seats are limited.)

Thank you all again for partnering with us in this ministry. Through your prayers and your financial contributions, God's love is being felt by the people who reside in care facilities and who cannot worship in a traditional church setting. As we partner together we will make great inroads to meeting the needs of the many people who often have nobody else to bring them spiritual services while they live out their lives in a care facility. May God richly bless you as you help us to love our neighbors as ourselves.
