Please pray for me as I am called to the constant task of encouraging others at times when their very souls are transitioning from this world to the next eternal one. My own faith is never in question, but I constantly struggle with what words to speak to each person when I do not know their faith. In the past few months I have had to go to the death beds of people who I know have faith as well as some who have not demonstrated that they have any faith at all. I find this task to be a great privilege but at the same time it is never without personal internal struggle.

Once again the Easter season is upon us! Easter is my favorite message to preach as it is the *essence* of the Christian faith. As part of your own Easter celebration I suggest that you might again read through 1 Corinthians 15:12-28 and confirm again the resurrection of our Lord and your own faith. Until next month I pray the Lord will keep you and sustain you.
